1. What Cookies Are

Cookies and similar technologies are small text files or storage entries placed on a browser or device to remember preferences, keep sessions secure, measure activity, or support product functionality.

2. How Cookies Are Used

Cookies may be used for login persistence, fraud prevention, session continuity, language choice, analytics measurement, feature testing, live-support tools, and product experience improvements.

3. Essential Cookies

Essential cookies support core features such as authentication, session security, CSRF protection, account continuity, and platform stability. Disabling them may prevent parts of the service from functioning correctly.

4. Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies help measure traffic patterns, product usage, and performance. Analytics output is used to improve onboarding, legal acceptance flow, navigation, and overall platform stability.

5. Functional Cookies

Functional cookies remember display preferences, language, product filters, support interactions, and other experience settings so the platform behaves consistently across visits.

6. Managing Cookie Preferences

Users can manage cookies through browser settings, device controls, or any cookie-preference tools made available on the site. Blocking some cookies may reduce platform functionality or prevent secure sign-in.
